

Junior Kindergarten Supply List

For rest time:

Small blanket OR beach towel
Small stuffed animal, pillow pet OR pillow
Pillow Case
(A mat sheet will be provided)

For your child's cubby:

Sturdy rain poncho
Seasonal change of clothes
(Shirt, pants/shorts or skirt, socks, underwear and sneakers)
Small storage box or shoebox (not more than 12 x 11 x 7.5 for clothing)

Please select a backpack into which your child may easily place his/her lunchbox, 9" x 12" school folder and miscellaneous items.

Please label all items with your child's name.

For the classroom:

3 boxes 5oz. paper cups
2 large boxes of tissues

KINDERGARTEN SUPPLY LIST

All items **MUST** be labeled with your child's name.

For your convenience supplies will be available in the R.P.S. bookstore. We request that the items conform to the specifications listed

- ❑ 1 **LARGE** backpack **NAME TO BE PUT INSIDE** – for your child's safety initials only on the outside
- ❑ 2 large boxes of aloe or lotion treated tissues
- ❑ 2 LARGE rolls paper towels
- ❑ 1 large beach towel and **crib sized** blanket packed inside a pillow protector with a zipper
- ❑ 2 boxes of 5 oz. kitchen or bathroom **paper** cups
- ❑ 2 boxes of rectangular baby wipes
- ❑ 1 **STURDY, CHILD-SIZED** raincoat or poncho. This will be left in school. It should be able to fit on top of a coat or sweater.
- ❑ 1 **COMPLETE CHANGE OF SEASONAL CLOTHES** including socks, underwear, pants, shirt, packed inside a box labeled with your child's name. Clothing should also be labeled. Include a plastic bag for transporting wet clothing home for laundering. Should fit into the hallway cubby space.
- ❑ 1 child sized 5" ambidextrous scissor
- ❑ 1 box EACH **8 CLASSIC COLORS** MARKERS – BROAD TIP AND THIN TIP
- ❑ 1- 16 pack of crayons
- ❑ 2 thin black or blue **dry erase** markers
- ❑ 1 **four oz. plastic bottle of Quick Drying Tacky Glue** – **RECOMMENDED BRAND – SCOTCH** – available at craft stores
- ❑ 1-box regular size #2 lead pencils – *please sharpen and put back into the box.*
- ❑ 1 hand eraser
- ❑ 1 box of **slider quart bags**
- ❑ 1 hard plastic supply box - 8 x 5 x 2"

1	marble composition book – 100 sheets (9 3/4 x 7 1/2 approx.) Primary Composition Lined
3	polyethylene pocket folders (9 1/2 x 11 1/2 approx.)
2	box # 2 pencils (Ticondaroga preferred) *
1	pair of blunt end scissors
2	large glue sticks
2	set of fine markers – 12 or 24 pack (Crayola preferred) *
1	box of colored pencils – 24 pack (Crayola preferred) *
1	hand eraser
2	large boxes of tissues *
1 or 2	Package(s) of baby wipes *
1	small vinyl or soft material pencil case (type normally put in 3 ring binder is fine)
1	rain poncho or rain jacket (in a pouch or a zip-loc plastic bag) or a small children's umbrella to be left at school in case of unexpected inclement weather
1	A "Complete Change of Clothes" to be left at school for emergencies (shirt and pants, underwear, socks, and a sweater) – These can be sent to school in a shoebox or a box small enough to fit into the hallway cubbies.

2013-2014 - Second Grade Supply List

- (1) three-ring hard covered binder with pockets - **1 INCH ONLY**
- (1) spacemaker supply box that is approximately 8"x5". It **MUST** fit in your desk with all of your books and should contain:
 - *1 set of crayons [24 pack]
 - *1 pair of scissors
 - *1 liquid white school glue
 - *1 eraser
 - *1 pencil sharpener
 - *2 large glue sticks
